

THINK OUT OF SQUARE

A NEW cafe on Whitmore Square is a win-win for hungry customers, as well as Adelaide's homeless.

The Cafe Out of The Square diner, a project by Adelaide businessmen **Mike Chalmers** and **Tim Seymour-Smith**, is providing on-the-job training for the underprivileged as well as meals for the neighbouring Vinnies Men's Crisis Centre.

Customers who stop in for a \$14.90 "square meal of the day" effectively "pay it forward", with the cost of the lunch providing two meals that night for the homeless, says Mike.

The cafe, open from 7am Tuesday to Sunday, is giving homeless and underprivileged people a chance to train in restaurant and bar work.
